Title of TA Multimedia e-publishing and e-book

A. Scope
To develop International Standards for multimedia e-books, multimedia e-publishing, and the related technologies, including; <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - formats of multimedia e-book contents, - minimum requirements for multimedia e-book viewers, - user interfaces for multimedia e-book viewers, - e-publishing services, and - guidelines for e-book distribution by interchangeable storage media.

B. Justification
In accordance with the suggestion (100/AGS203, 100/AGS207) of the 18th AGS meeting in San Jose, the new TA of the scope is proposed. There are two existing projects (PT 62229 and PT 62448) to be allocated in the new TA. As shown in the discussion of AGS meetings, new project proposals for this area, e.g., Reader's format for multimedia e-publishing and Proofreading in e-publishing environment, will be expected.
